WHAT IS THE FUNCTION OF THE THEATRE? We believe with Arthur Hopkins: "When a thousand people sit before us, appealingly receptive, how are we to enrich them? How often in our lives has theatregoing been an experience for which we will be forever grateful?...Are we to send people away exalted, compassionate, proud of being human beings, or are we to add to their frustration and cynicism? Chain reactions did not begin with the atomic bomb. It began with ideas. The theatre is essentially a place of ideas. What chain reactions do we want to set in motion?

THIS SEASON MARKS a turningpoint in the Gateway's ever changing history, with TEN productions rather than five, and a company of 18 instead of 8.

IN THE BEGINNING the Gateway was nothing but an empty barn and a handful of idealistic actors. Six vears ago a press notice said, "The Gateway Players, a recently organized group of young actors will make their bow at 8:30 p.m. tomorrow in Shakespeare's "Taming of the Shrew", to be presented in the new 'theatre-in-the-round'." The following week a review said "If this youthful, enthusiastic company maintains as high a standard with its next production..... Bellport and the surrounding area is in for an enjoyable summer of interesting theatre."

NOW SUCCESSFUL the Gateway Theatre operates a student workshop which enrolls some thirty resident teenagers as well as adults from this area. Courses in all phases of the theatre are given daily in addition to student productions and dance concerts... the actors in the professional companies providing the drama instruction. Gateway is a member of the American National Theatre and Academy, and the American Educational Theatre Association.

THE ENSEMBLE consists of Sally Pomeran who returns to Bellport after a season in Europe. One of Gateway's founders, now general director. Miss Pomeran has had an extensive career in New York and on tour, the most vivid roles being in "Antigone", "Liliom", "Pygmalion", and "Taming of the Shrew". Educated at Principia College and Columbia University, Miss Pomeran studied drama under Frank Parker and then acted with C. W. T. in N. Y. for 3 yrs. and played leading roles at the Putney Theatre in Vermont, She is now leaving her post as head of the Putney School Drama Dept. to lead the Gateway Players in winter repertory.

DAVID SHELDON, also a Gateway founder, returns for his sixth acting and directing season in Bellport. Noted for a variety of char-(Cont'd on Pg.4)

acter roles, Mr. Sheldon played the Gentleman Caller in "Glass Menagerie" and "Imaginary Invalid" last season. Appearances in Illinois. New York and Connecticut include radio acting and experimental TV. Having studied at Principia College and his MFA at Yale Drama School. This season Mr. Sheldon is directing one of his own plays. Mr. Sheldon is now director of Gateway's Student Workshop.

BEVERLY WHITE, directing five of Gateway's ten productions, comes from Arena Stage, Washington, D.C. Formerly director of drama at the Putney School in Vermont. Miss White established the Putney Summer Theatre in 1947 and directed its work for six years. In the summer of 1950 she toured the British Isles with members of her company, representing the U.S.A. in an international festival sponsored by the British Drama League. Miss White has been associated with Weston Playhouse. Rollins Studio and McLean Summer Theatre and has instructed in the theatre departments of Wesleyan Univ. and Sarah Lawrence College.

GEORGE BUTLER, one of Gateway's founders, is back after an absence of two seasons during which he played leading roles with America's only professional Gilbert and Sullivan company in N. Y. Gateway audiences will remember him as Earnest in "The Importance of Being Earnest". which he also directed; his Antrobus in "Skin of Our Teeth", his stage manager in

NOEL COWARD

Mr. Coward's variety of talents is only further proof of his enslavement to work. Being actor, composer, playwright, producer - has inspired a sheaf of awed treatises. He is a great wit and his facility of expression has made him the envy of other dramatists. And who else can turn out hit plays within a space of a week? Mr. Coward turned actor at the age of twelve, playwright at twenty-one, and leading man in his own first London production. Also having written operettas, revues, and musical comedies, he has also given us a half a dozen books, short stories, sketches and lyrics, essays and satirical portraits.

To the American theatre alone. Mr. Coward has contributed eleven hits: "The Vortex", "This Year of Grace", "Private Lives", "Tonight at 8:30", "Design for Living", "Hay Fever", "Easy Virtue", "Charlot's Revue", "Fallen Angels", "This Was a Man", "The Marquise", "Bitter Sweet", "Conversation Piece", "Point Valaine", "Set to Music" and "Blithe Spirit". When war was declared in 1942 he left "Present Laughter" and "This Happy Breed" in their dress rehearsal stage to accept a post in the British Naval Intelligence. In 1945 he played in his revue "Sigh No More", and in 1947 Mary Martin and Graham Payn starred for him in "Pacific 1860". His previous hits starred Gertrude Lawrence, Beatrice Lillie, Alred Lunt, Lynn Fontanne, Tallulah Bankhead, and Clifton Webb.

"Blithe Spirit" was produced several years ago on film, featuring Rex Harrison as Charles, and Margaret Rutherford as Madame Arcati.

"Our Town". Mr. Butler has participated in the Shakespearian festival in Dock St. Theatre, N.Y. An accomplished singer and pianist, he comes to Bellport after a season in Europe and a year at the Goodman Theatre in Europe.

Appearing with the Encore Players in New York, Mr. Daprato has done off-Broadway work for a number of years appearing in such plays as '"Of Mice and Men".
