PAUL FORD(Elwood P. Dowd).

Mr. Ford is famous for his roles as a frustrated authority figure: "Colonel Hall" in the "Sgt. Bilko" series, "Colonel Purdy" in the Broadway, movie and television versions of "Teahouse of the August Moon", and the retired air force colonel in "It's a Mad, Mad World". He has played classic roles in many films, including "The Music Man", "Matchmaker" and "The Russians are Coming". Mr. Ford has appeared in major television shows such as "Playhouse 90", "DuPont Show of the Month", "Alfred Hitchcock", "Johnny Carson", and in his own series, "The Baileys of Balboa". He won unanimous critical acclaim for his performance in the Broadway version of "A Thurber Carnival" and for his role in the stage and film productions of "Never Too Late". Mr. Ford appears as "Mr. Smith" in the recent film "The Comedians".

RUTH McDEVITT was the original Mom Peepers on the Mr. Peepers Show on television and has played leads in such long run productions on Broadway as "Arsenic and Old Lace", "Harvey", "Picnic", "The Solid Gold Cadillac" and "The Best Man". Other TV assignments have included U. S. Steel, The Nurses, and Dr. Kildare. She was featured in the movies "The Birds", "Love is a Ball", "The Parent Trap", and "Boys Night Out".

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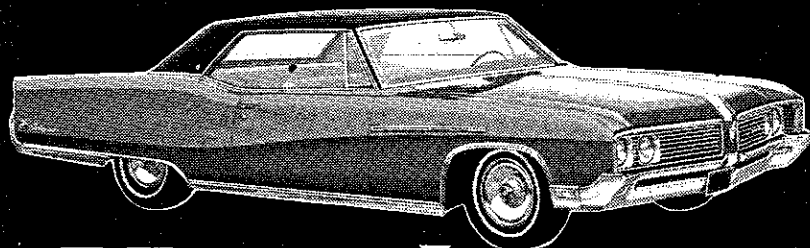
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'HARVEY' -- WHO'S WHO

She was in "Never Too Late", with Martha Scott and Dennis O'Keefe, and later with Arthur Godfrey and Maureen O'Sullivan. Other stage credits include "Middle of the Night", with Edward G. Robinson, "Dark at the Top of the Stairs" and "Look Homeward Angel".

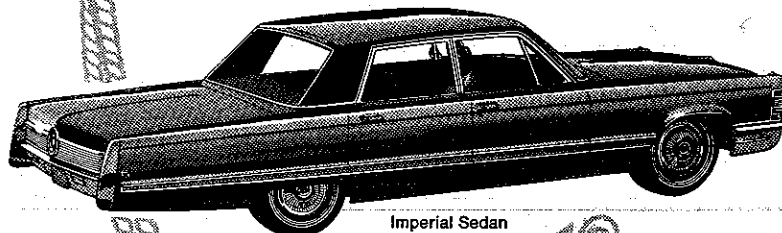
