
#### A Brief History of PETER PAN

Peter Pan opened 75 years ago (1904) in London starring Nina Boucicault, an actress well known at the time. Americans first met "the boy who wouldn't grow up" in 1905, when Maude Adams, an American, opened in Broadway's Peter Pan. A perennial favorite in England, Peter has been played by some of the greatest ladies of the stage including Fay Compton, Gladys Cooper, Elsa Lancaster, Anna Neagle, Glynis Johns, Margaret Lockwood, Joan Greenwood and Maggie Smith. Americans have been no less enthusiastic. Maude Adams revived Peter Pan three times, musical comedy

star Marilyn Miller played Peter in the 1920's, and Eva Le Gallienne starred in and co-directed the play for her Civic Repertory Company. Jean Arthur and Boris Karloff were Broadway's Peter Pan and Captain Hook in the 1950 production, which had a few songs composed by Leonard Bernstein. The present full musical version came to Broadway 25 years ago (1954) with Mary Martin and Cyril Ritchard.

The Hospital for Sick Children of London is the owner of the copyright of the basic work, Peter Pan by Sir James M. Barrie, upon which this musical is based.
