





If you applauded the salvation of the London Bridge - despite the unsettling vision of its new digs being in the Arizona desert - you'll be enchanted to know that Skitch Henderson's popular Manhattan watering hole, Daly's Dandelion, is alive and well - if not intact - and living in Bellport.

The "porch" from that famous and recently demolished Third Avenue meeting place is now part of the BK on Main Street.



It has now expanded from a soda fountain atmosphere (albiet pizzazzier than most soda dispensing establishments), into a full-fledged and elegant dining room with a fully stocked bar that dominates the main dining area.

Its three-sided shape - refashioned by Bob and Steve from the original counter is bound to please many seeking social diversion.

The BK will still serve up the very special homemade dishes for which it has become known - but more of them. Helping to keep the kitchen producing its specialties will be a super cookerwoman, Pam Raymond, who has graced the kitchens of the Old Inlet Inn in Bellport and the Casino Beach Inn on Fire Island.

The BK is open for breakfast on weekends only. Lunch and dinner are served seven days a week and, after 11 p.m., there is a supper menu available.





Who's Who



DENNIS SOMES (Vernon) is a native of Philadelphia and comes to Gateway having just completed a part in the soon-to-be released movie "Lonely Guys," starring Steve Martin. 


