





#### ABOUT CITY OF ANGELS

A cleverly crafted Musical about the nostalgic Hollywood era of 1940's filmmaking, CITY OF ANGELS combines two separate but intertwined subplots on the same stage in an entertaining and interesting way.

The first subplot deals with a writer of mystery novels, Stine, and his first attempt at penning a movie adaptation of his classic novel. The second plot portrays the actual movie-scripted scenes that Stine writes for his central private-eye character, Stone, in the movie "City of Angels" as well as the world of intrigue and murder reminiscent of the classic Mike Hammer films of the 1940's.

As Stine becomes more and more involved with his fictitious creations, both the real-world scenes (depicted in color) and the scenes of his movie script (depicted in classic black and white) become intertwined.

Stine bases his movie-bound personas on the real-world people he meets. Both "Movie" characters and their real-world role models are cleverly portrayed in this musical by the same actor. For instance, Stine's real-world producer director Buddy Fidler becomes the movie character, Irwin S. Irving; Donna, Buddy Fidler's Secretary becomes the movie character Oolie - Secretary to Stone, the Movie's Central private-eye character, and so forth.

As Stine envisions his movie scenes and their re-writes in his mind and on the type-written page, these film scenarios unfold on the stage in an interesting cinemagraphic way. As Stine is affected by his real-world experiences and environments, his "Movie" scenes begin to mirror his trials and tribulations in an "Art Imitates Life" fashion.

Through this clever use of Color, identical Black and White replicas of real-world environments, and the portrayal of both "Movie" and "Real-life" characters by the same actor; CITY OF ANGELS provides for an entertaining and enjoyable trip back to the glamorous world of Hollywood in the 1940's. Enjoy!
