





dam Wylie can't remember a time when he wasn't acting - he began making commercials at age four - and he wouldn't have it any other way. "It would be really strange to do anything else

and I think I would be bored," he said, "I would feel that something was missing. If I wasn't performing I would feel that part of me died." Best known for his role as Sheriff Brock's youngest son Zack on the acclaimed series Picket Fences, Adam grew up California, the youngest of six children, and his nonstop career has included movies (Kindergarten Cop, Cutaway), television (The Michael Landon Story), and voiceovers (All Dogs Go To Heaven II. The

King And I). His first love, though, is theater.

"The first time I was in a theater I was three days old, and theater is the first place I ever performed. When I get older I want to build my own theater," he said. "I would like to produce. Directing doesn't really appeal to me, but if I did it I'd want to direct a stage production. I could get my whole family involved, my brothers Eric and Ben are both in show business and we are even thinking eventually of forming a production company together." Adam also met his girlfriend, actress Meagan Smith, in the theater. "She


was Frenchie and I was Danny Zuko in a kids' production of Grease," he said. Adam's theater credits include roles in West Coast productions of *The Music Man, Carousel*, *Oliver*, and *Peter Pan*, as well as originating

the role of Chip in the Los Angeles production of *Beauty And The Beast*.

Somehow, Adam still finds time to study Kung-Fu and plays on three roller hockey teams. He has just graduated high school, but his busy performing schedule didn't interfere with schoolwork: times it even helped! "When I was in a show, they would have a teacher on the set me." Adam explained, "My school would fax the work and I would take the

tests when I got back or with the set teacher supervising. When I wasn't working I'd go right back to school and sometimes I would be a few lessons ahead of the class which was nice. Especially with math, I'm so bad at math."

Although he is now at an age when many child performers choose to leave show business for other careers, Adam's path is certain. Sometimes the best way isn't straight, and I have curved a lot," he said, "But I plan to do anything I can, whatever keeps me working is what I'm going to do."





#### Spotlight On...

#### INTERNSHIP

Gateway Playhouse has a long history of training and educating young people in the theater arts in the 1950's and 60's it was nationally renowned for its actors-in-training apprentice program in which students learned not just acting, but every aspect of production.

While there is no longer an internship program for actors (although the Gateway Acting School offers classes for all ages) Gateway hires a handful of interns every summer to work as technicians. Usually of high school or college

freshman age, they learn to construct sets, paint scenery, and handle props and costumes. For most of them, this is their first time working in a professional theater environment.

"It will be a difficult adjustment to work on high school productions again," said Krystle DiNicola, a Patchogue-Medford High

student interning for the first time this year,"I have found the business to be demanding but enjoyable, and this wondrous opportunity has helped to strengthen my resolution to pursue a career in this field of work." Brittany Fahner, a senior at Bellport High School, worked as a spotlight operator during the 2000 holiday shows, and is also spending her first summer as an intern. "It's a lot more work than I expected, but it is still a lot of fun and I learned a lot while running shows," she said.

As the Technical Director, Bobby Edgar supervises the interns working in the scene shop. "I like working with people who want to learn, and they do learn the real way things are done as opposed

to reading a textbook," he said. Gateway operates on a two week set construction schedule, and the interns are dropped in at the deep end, work-

ing I3-plus hours a day for a small weekly stipend. "I take into consideration what they want to do, whether it is sound or lighting or painting," said Edgar, "and I try to give them time on that, as well as use them to accomplish our goals. I also keep in mind that for the most part their parents are chauf-

> feuring them, so they can't work the same hours that my carpenters do."

> The interns make contacts that can help them land jobs in professional theater later in their careers. Gateway itself often hires former interns, including Production Stage Manager, Erin Kraus. "I was a General Theater Studies major at Emerson College,

and I thought if I was going to decide what I wanted to specialize in, I should intern somewhere," she said. "It was here that I learned I wasn't very good at building scenery! So I got to work a lot with painting, costumes, and props. While I was working with Kevin Frederick (Gateway's stage manager during the 1999 season) I decided I wanted to be a stage manager. And having been an intern here helps me now understand where they are coming from." Isabella Gregory, another Bellport student, also feels she found her niche here. "I worked as a dresser on Steel Pier and for the ice show. Then this summer I began interning, and I did costumes and painted. I want to go to college for producing and directing film, but my second option is theater, and now that I've been working as the Assistant Stage Manager, I think stage managing is what I would like."

Although the work is hard, the hours are long, and the pay is slight, Gateway interns seem to enjoy the experience. "There is so much support here. When you do something everybody says 'thank you' or 'great job'," said Fahner. Soon the season will be over, the interns will return to school and eventually begin their careers, but they will have become part of the enduring tradition of mentoring at Gateway Playhouse.


