We are at the close of our 52nd summer season, and looking back, we believe it was one of our best. Fiddler On The Roof and Annie Get Your Gun delighted a new generation of patrons, our productions of Forbidden Broadway and Ragtime brought these shows to Long Island audiences for the very first time, and the re-conception of Jesus Christ Superstar challenged both the production team and the audience to regard the greatest story ever told in a completely new light. ## FEATURED PERFORMERS -

It is almost as if it were preordained that director Charlie Marcus' and choreographer Desirée Duarte's careers would lead them to *Swing!* Marcus began playing the trumpet at nine, and by 13 had his own dance band. "We called it The Dance Band," he said, "and everybody's parents hired us to play little gigs in their backyards." After going through his high school's jazz program where he learned to scat sing, he thought he should switch his focus away from trumpet, and attended Boston Conservatory Of Music to "become the next Gene Kelly." He got his first break right out of college, playing Al Deluca toward the end of *A Chorus Line*'s Broadway run. In the next years, he acted in five European tours, but didn't really do a lot of trumpet playing.

Duarte began dance lessons at six, working intensely at it from 9-14. "Then I got burned out," she laughed, "and in high school I discovered clubs and student government, and went to college for psychology. I signed up for a dance class to stay in shape, and found I had really missed it, so I double-majored." Her first professional experience was dancing for two seasons with the San Francisco 49ers Gold Rush Dance Team, then she came to New York. "I was pretty overwhelmed when I got there, and wasn't focusing on anything. One night a friend took me out to Louisiana's and I fell in love with swing. At that time, there was a place to go every night of the week if you wanted. I learned to swing dance just by going, and experimented with friends, did industrial gigs."

Then *Swing!* happened. "I heard they were auditioning and I thought, that is my show. If I'm right for any Broadway show, this is it," said Duarte, "I went through so many calls, but I was so calm and confident, it was like it was all coming together." She didn't get the workshop but later was asked to audition for the show. "I went in with *two* partners so I got seen twice! When they called to say I got the show, it was like everything looked brighter, everything was outlined!" Marcus said, "I saw the show on Broadway, they had a band leader and a leading man, and I didn't know how I'd fit in, but then they decided to combine the two characters for the National Tour. "I spent six weeks preparing my audition, I did a little of everything, sang, tapped, played my trumpets. After I got the job,



I asked Broadway and film choreographer Lynn Taylor Corbett, 'where's my big feature?' And she said, 'what do you want to do? Let's discuss it.' She is terrific like that. It was a great opportunity to add my own song, and since then it's been included in the score."

Duarte has done every production of *Swing!* – she was in the original Broadway cast, did the first National Tour, worked on the first regional production in California, and is now here at Gateway. "It is definitely my passion," she said.

Both Marcus and Duarte give Corbett a lot of the credit for their involvement. "A very big part of what we are doing out here is Lynn, and her support and guidance along the way. Having learned from her, we are putting our stamp on the next company," said Marcus. Duarte added, "Almost everyone in this cast has done the show before, and it would be impossible to do it at the level we are doing it in a two week rehearsal period with all brand new people. We are working more on *how* we are doing things, not what. Swing is a different language, it's a whole new dance style and technique."

The show has been their lives for the past few years, and Marcus and Duarte hope they will continue to work on it. "I enjoy this position so much, and I look forward to creating original things," said Duarte, "but I will always enjoy teaching this show, it is so rewarding."

## THANK YOU MIL AND NANCY

Mil and Nancy Kana have been greeting Gateway patrons with a friendly smile for over 20 years as members of the House Staff. But Swing! marks the end of an era – the Kanas are retiring and Swing! is their last show. "Mil and Nancy are probably the most recognized staff members at Gateway," said Jeff Bellante, Associate Producer, "Maybe it is because of their 30 plus years of service, but more than likely it is because they are present at every single performance. Mil is there to greet the customers at the bar and Nancy is posted at the box office or taking tickets. Even after all these years, you cannot convince them to take the night off."

Nancy started more than 30 years ago when there were only 10 weeks in the season. She had worked with Harry Pomeran, Gateway's founder, on a church Christmas pageant and he asked her if she would be interested in a summer job selling tickets. "We could do it then with just two girls," remembered Nancy, "and we counted tickets by hand." The current box office was one-third its size then, and a second one for this-performance-only tickets stood where the men's room is now. "Nancy has been here as long as I can remember," said Paul Allan, producer, "She and my grandfather worked side by side and taught me how to sell tickets before I was even a teenager. She has worked along side of three generations of producers! It's been a pleasure having someone as pleasant, loyal, and talented as Nancy in our Gateway family for so many years." When computers were brought



in five years ago, Nancy at first was skeptical, "I thought, that's it, this is my last year. But little by little it came to me, and everybody was so patient, and the following year I couldn't believe I was teaching other people how to do it!" As box office manager, Nancy supervised the employees working in Gateway's box offices in Bellport and at the Smithaven Mall location. "We don't have someone just answer-

ing the phone or just working the window, you have to take care of the whole customer, and that adds variety to the work," Nancy said.

Mil has handled the concession at Gateway since he retired from his job in 1983. He's at every performance, including Children's Theatre shows, and has served thousands of patrons. "I really enjoy it," he said, "After a while, you talk to the same people and you learn the names of their children. Now some of the patrons I saw when they were children bring their own children." Allan said, "The concession area is synonymous with Mil - he's always been there, and keeps everything so neat and orderly. He'll be a tough act to follow. We sure will miss 'Kups' Kana."

"I see our jobs as making the people smile, and I tell the other House Staff employees to remember we are almost always the only people that patrons talk to at Gateway," said Nancy, "I think it is important that the people see the spirit of the Allan family through us".

The Kanas will be leaving Bellport soon, but they will always be a part of Gateway Playhouse. Bellante said, "We will certainly miss them next year as will our customers. I wonder if we can do it without them? It has never been tried before." Good luck, Mil and Nancy, and thank you for everything. It won't be the same here without you.






