

Letter from the Artistic Director

Holidays are rich in tradition. There is something comforting in feeling attached to many years of human souls all rejoicing in the goodness that is represented by the December Holidays. In conceiving this production, I decided it would be fun to travel through this century, taking a glimpse, a snapshot, of each decade's Christmas past. As I began to formulate each time period, scenarios came to mind that best depicted the celebrations in feel and flavor. I also wanted each decade's major entertainment/ media venue to be a backdrop. Paul Allan, our producer, had already booked T. J. Howell, our juggler and the O'Donnell's animal act because of their popularity in past Spectaculars and they needed to be incorporated into the ongoing thru-lines. Together with Patrick Kelly, our Musical Director and Arranger, I chose songs that had to fit into each setting, which would be sung by the characters within their given circumstances. This was an interesting process, in that we wanted to remain faithful to the period in only using songs that had been written at the time, or were versions of songs that had been written previously. Patrick listened to many different arrangements and offered suggestions. When most of the music was decided, I started the casting process and he began orchestrating. In writing the script, I found written stories and sketches that leant themselves easily to what I wanted depicted, in addition to what I wrote from scratch. I enlisted the help of a very talented writer, Julien Schwab, for the 1970's and 1980's and handed off my idea for the 1990's to be written by Director/Choreographer, DJ Salisbury, who came on board during the end of this process. I knew we were in good hands the first time I walked into rehearsal and saw his work in the studio and the show taking shape. DJ's inventive ideas added the necessary sparkle and pizzazz. All in all, the making of the show turned into a journey itself. Hope it brings you your own Christmas Memories!






