









## A Letter from the Producer





# **Production Choices**

Following the end of the first World War, a ravaged Germany was dependent on American loans to rebuild. When the Great Depression hit in 1929, the money financing those loans disappeared overnight. Berlin was plunged into overwhelming economic depression, and politics were polarized.

It is against this desperate backdrop that Cabaret is set. The show debuted in 1966, was heavily revised for the 1972 movie, revived in 1987, and most recently in 1997. When the show closed on Broadway in January, Gateway obtained the rights...for the 1987 version. "I wanted to give the artistic staff as much creative freedom as I could," Producer Paul Allan explained, "the most recent revival version is available, but we would have to follow the '97 director Sam Mendes' choices so closely that it would really be copying a production, not creating something ourselves," he said. Director Dominick Ruggiero described how his vision has a different center. "The '97 revival focused on the sexuality and the decadence. I am focusing on the social background and what was going on in the period. It is a very sobering piece, it is not a light musical," he said.

This is the fourth time Gateway has mounted *Cabaret*. Robin Joy Allan, Artistic Director and Casting Director explained the appeal to Gateway of doing the show again. "We like doing shows that have a political angle, and it's very important to show people that desperation and fear lead to evil and destruction. We are now living in terror, and there is a sense of desperation. This is a per-

fect time for something horrible to happen if we are not open to our fellow men," she said. Ruggiero agrees, "I believe this show is as timely now as when it was written in the '60's. In essence the show is timeless because it deals with bigotry, and how people are falsely led to believe what is right and wrong."

Robin kept the forced gaiety and frantic despair of the time in mind when casting the show. "I like to find people who resemble, facially, interesting types from the period of the show," she explained. "If you are doing *Grease*, you have Sandra Dee and Frankie Avalon images in mind. So for *Cabaret*, I was looking for faces that suggested Europe in the 1930's. We were looking for actors who had two sides, who could represent the stylishness of the time, but yet have a dark side. This show's characters are so conflicted, the actors had to be multidimensional."

Cabaret culture was at its height in Germany in the 1920's. By 1931, the year in



which Cabaret takes place, the acts began softening their political and social commentary and the master of ceremonies was left to maintain the cabaret's satirical essence, much as the Emcee does in the show. "This show has real

bite, you can stir strong thoughts in an audience," said Ruggiero, "there are double entendres, symbols, metaphors for everything. What's in between the lines plays more."

The cabaret culture was one of the first wictims of Nazi terror when Hitler took power in 1933. Performers and writers were sent to concentration camps, others left the country. "Through the staging and visuals, the audience will understand what happened in



Germany then," said Ruggiero. "I would like the audience to consider the parallels of how a small group manipulated the rest of a nation, and if that might happen again." Allan sums it up "As an artistic venue producing a work

with a political theme that deals with recent history, we consider that our audiences already have a very distinct view of the circumstances. In this case we find it important to stay true what the original creators intended for the piece while approaching it with our own insight, in order to spark the minds and hearts of our audiences. Art should always inspire thought. That's all we can ask."


