





The Yontzmat Portable Jee Rink

Yontzmat portable ice rinks are state of the art ice rinks utilizing space age materials and solar technology. The Yontz Corporation, headed by Don Yontz and Carl Zahn, and their team of engineers can transform a stage into skatable ice in only 24 hours. The rink is framed using recycled "plastic" lumber forming what resembles a 5-1/2 inch deep water bed frame. Next, a polyethylene plastic liner is placed over one inch thick high density insulation. Yontzmat "coils" (which are constructed from HiTemp solar collector material) are laid on top of the plastic liner and connected to one end of the frame. This end of the frame has piping which will pump 65 gallons per minute of antifreeze through the paneled coils at 5 degrees Fahrenheit. The antifreeze is chilled by a 60 HP unit which is parked outside the theatre. After the rink is down, it is continuously watered to build the layers of ice. The entire installation takes only 4 hours and the ice builds to skating thickness in only 20 hours. When the fun is over, the entire rink is removed in 4 hours or less by a team of 12 people. Gateway utilizes only environmentally friendly antifreeze in the coolant system.


