

• The moniker "Rat Pack" originally referred to an inner circle of Hollywood superstars who embraced honesty and good character. Led by Humphrey Bogart through the 1950's, the informal group included Bogart's wife Lauren Bacall, Judy Garland, Cary Grant, Rex Harrison, Katharine Hepburn, Sid Luft, Frank Sinatra and Spencer Tracy. Sinatra assumed leadership of the group after Bogart's death in 1957.

• Sinatra's Rat Pack (with Dean Martin, Sammy Davis Jr., Joey Bishop and Peter Lawford) embodied diversity. One was black, one was Jewish, one was British and two were Italian. Three were second-generation immigrants

and four were raised in ethnic urban neighborhoods during the Depression. One had significant nerve damage in his lower arm and another had a prosthetic eye.

• The Summit at The Sands lounge act played a four week engagement while shooting the original Ocean's 11. It is considered the signature moment of The Pack and is recreated in The Rat Pack is Back! After filming, they





partied through two sold-out shows each night at The Sands Hotel & Casino. The fun

> continued late into the night, and the group slept during the day, waking only if they were needed on set.

> • "The Summit" refers to the tense Paris Summit between Cold War-era leaders Charles de Gaulle, Dwight D. Eisenhower, Nikita Khrushchev and Harold MacMillian.

• The Pack frequented casinos along the Vegas Strip before and after their shows, many of which still denied entry to



blacks, including high-profile entertainers like Sammy Davis Jr. The ring-a-ding group boycotted segregated establishments in full sight of their press attaché until the entire swinging conglomerate was allowed in.

• The Summit's pop-culture phenomenon crescendoed when presidential candidate John F. Kennedy attended the semiimprovised show. Rat Pack-er Peter Lawford, christened "Brother-in-Lawford" by Sinatra, was Patricia Kennedy's husband. Later that year, Sinatra & friends played a key role in the Kennedy campaign.



He has since received much acclaim for his uncanny recreation, appearing in several shows in Las Vegas as Dean Martin, including "Ole Blue Eyes" and "Vegas Headliners." It was around this time that Johnny had set his sights on the The Rat Pack is Back which also makes its home in Vegas. Through hard work and perseverance, Johnny fine tuned his portraval of Dean Martin to the level that would bring him to their stage, side by side with some of the most talented professionals in the business.

Being a perfectionist, he is always looking to bring a new dynamic to his portrayal of Dean Martin. Making it look easy is probably the hardest thing to do and that is the challenge that makes Johnny set his goal to be the best.

The title song (which he wrote with Rodney) was nominated for a Grammy Award.

His post-Rodney career has seen him opening for a multitude of celebrities such as Tom Jones, The Beach Boys, Natalie Cole, Garry Shandling, Joan Rivers, George Wallace, Gloria Estefan, Joy Behar, Jackie Mason, and the late, great George Carlin, with whom he toured

- Co-hosted "The Stephanie Miller Show" on KTLA Radio with his friend Elayne Boosler






